How to Get to Coimbra?

By Air

Porto: Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (OPO) – approx. 110 km

Lisbon: Humberto Delgado Airport (LIS) – approx. 210 km

From Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (Porto) to Coimbra

Inside the terminal, follow the signs for the Metro do Porto. Take Line E (Violet) towards Campanhã station (approx. 30 minutes; departures every 20-30 minutes).

From Campanhã, you may:

1) take a train (Alfa Pendular or Intercidades) to Coimbra-B

Travel time: 1h09 to 1h22 (depending on the service)

Tickets must be purchased in advance

Coimbra-B is about 2 km from the city centre

2) take a bus (FlixBus or Rede Expressos) to Coimbra.

Travel time: 1h20 to 1h35

Tickets must be purchased in advance



Alternative: Direct buses run from Porto Airport to Coimbra (FlixBus or Rede Expressos), with a travel time of approximately 1h50.

From Humberto Delgado Airport (Lisbon) to Coimbra

Upon leaving the arrivals area, follow the signs to the Metro. Take the Red Line to Oriente station (approx. 10-15 minutes; departures every 6-12 minutes).

Alternatively, you may take a Carris bus (e.g., route 736) which also connects the airport to Oriente.

From Oriente, you may:

1) take a train (Alfa Pendular or Intercidades) to Coimbra-B

Travel time: 1h36 to 2h00

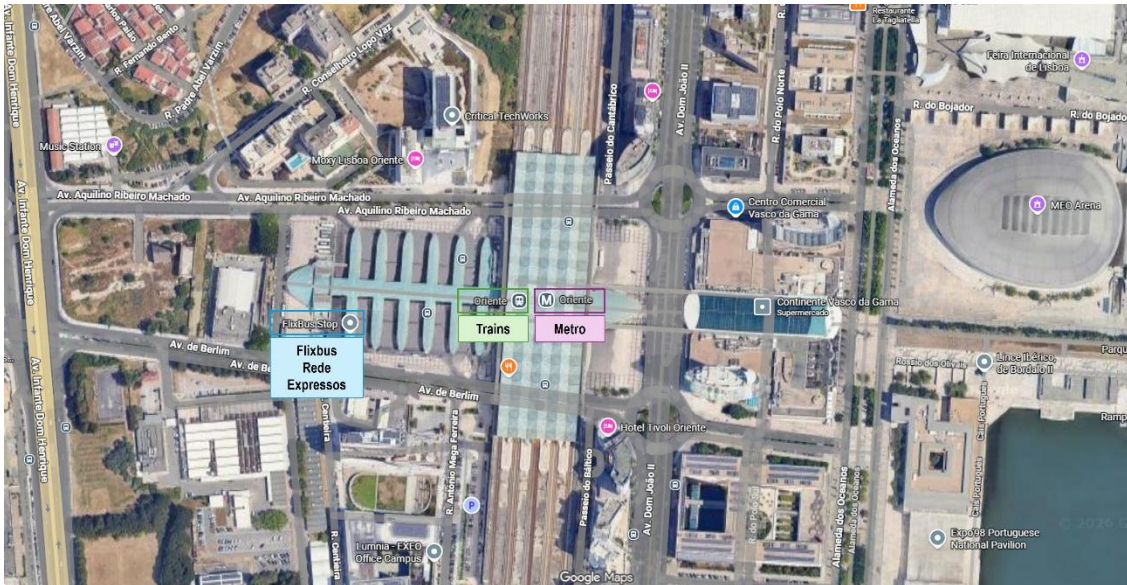
Tickets must be purchased in advance

Coimbra-B is about 2 km from the city centre

2) take a bus (FlixBus or Rede Expressos) to Coimbra.

Travel time: 2h15 to 2h20

Tickets must be purchased in advance



Alternative: Direct buses run from Lisbon Airport to Coimbra (FlixBus or Rede Expressos), taking approximately 2h40.

Beyond the University, Coimbra invites visitors to explore its charming old town, with narrow streets, traditional cafés, and scenic river views. The city is also known for its distinctive Fado de Coimbra, a musical tradition closely linked to student life.
